CHAPTER IV
Rights and duties of Relatives

367. Relatives by blood have the duty to provide support in the following order:

1. Ascendants and descendants, primarily the ones closest in degree and in the case of relatives related in the same degree, those who are in the best position to provide support.

2. Siblings and half-siblings.

The obligation between relatives to provide support is reciprocal.

376 bis. Parents, guardians of minors and disabled persons, or those who have under their responsibility elderly people who are either ill or disabled, shall grant visitation rights to relatives who, according to the provisions set forth in this chapter, are mutually bound to provide support. In case of an objection on grounds of possible damage to the moral or physical well-being of the persons concerned, the judge shall issue in summary proceedings the corresponding order, establishing the most convenient visitation rights arrangement according to the case.
