



## Introduction

La *Convention du 29 mai 1993 sur la protection des enfants et la coopération en matière d'adoption internationale* (« Convention Adoption de 1993 ») prévoit la collecte et l'échange de statistiques sur l'adoption internationale afin de promouvoir la coopération entre Autorités centrales, de vérifier que les garanties sont respectées et de faciliter la prestation de services post-adoption. L'accès à ces statistiques permet aux parties prenantes de suivre le fonctionnement de la Convention, d'élaborer des orientations et d'identifier les bonnes pratiques en matière d'adoption internationale.

Le Guide de bonnes pratiques No 1 de la HCCH reconnaît l'utilité des statistiques pour mesurer l'efficacité de la mise en œuvre de la Convention Adoption de 1993 (para. 189). Recoupées avec des données économiques et démographiques, les statistiques peuvent notamment aider les parties prenantes à saisir la nature fondamentale de l'adoption internationale et à suivre ses tendances dans le temps et dans l'espace.

Les dernières réunions de la Commission spéciale (CS) ont également souligné l'importance, pour les États parties, de soumettre annuellement des statistiques générales au Bureau Permanent au moyen des formulaires standard prévus à cet effet (Rec. No 9 de la CS de 2005, Rec. No 30 de la CS de 2010 et Rec. No 49 de la CS de 2015). En conséquence, le Bureau Permanent saurait gré aux États de bien vouloir renseigner les formulaires standard mis à jour de chaque année, de l'année 2000 à l'année en cours, s'ils ne l'ont pas déjà fait (il n'est pas nécessaire de soumettre à nouveau les statistiques déjà envoyées pour les années passées).
