2007 Child Support Convention and Maintenance Protocol: update and future work

I. Introduction

- 1 This document reports on the work carried out, and the progress made, in relation to projects pertaining to the *Convention of 23 November 2007 on the International Recovery of Child Support and Other Forms of Family Maintenance* (2007 Child Support Convention or 2007 Convention) and the *Protocol of 23 November 2007 on the Law Applicable to Maintenance Obligations* (Maintenance Obligations Protocol or Protocol) since the Council on General Affairs and Council (CGAP) 2025. The work pertaining to the International Transfer of Maintenance Funds Experts' Group (ITMFEG) and the electronic case management and secure communication system (iSupport) are reported on in separate Preliminary Documents (Prel. Docs).¹
- 2 Section II reports on Post-Convention Assistance and on the updated electronic Country Profile under the 2007 Convention. Section III reports on treaty actions in relation to the 2007 Convention and its Protocol since CGAP 2025. Section IV outlines the results of consultations undertaken in preparation of a possible Second Meeting of the Special Commission (SC) on the practical operation of the 2007 Convention and its Protocol. Section V mentions outstanding matters and future work. Section VI proposes ways forward for the consideration of the Council on General Affairs and Council (CGAP).

II. Treaty actions since CGAP 2025

- 3 Following the deposit of its instrument of accession to the 2007 Convention in February 2025, the Convention came into force for El Salvador on 7 February 2026. Following its ratification of the 2007 Convention in March 2025, the Convention came into force for Colombia on 1 July 2025. Finally, the Convention came into force for Denmark on 1 October 2025, following the deposit of its instrument of ratification on 30 June 2025. The Convention is now in force for 56 Contracting Parties.²
- 4 There has been no treaty action for the Protocol since CGAP 2025.

III. Post-Convention Assistance and updated e-Country Profile under the 2007 Convention

- 5 From 29 September to 1 October 2025, the PB provided a three-day training session on the 2007 Convention to representatives of the judiciary and the Central Authority, as well as members of the legal professions and enforcement officers in Azerbaijan. The training session was also attended by representatives of the judiciary of Kazakhstan.
- 6 Since the release of the e-Country Profile in August 2025, 12 Contracting Parties to the 2007 Convention have published for the first time or updated their Country Profile using the new service. The Permanent Bureau (PB) will continue its efforts to invite States joining the Convention to make their Country Profiles available in accordance with Article 57(1) of the Convention.³

IV. Results of consultations undertaken in preparation of a possible Second Meeting of the SC

- 7 Following CGAP 2025, the PB circulated an initial questionnaire,⁴ outlining potential topics for discussion at a possible Second Meeting of the SC and inviting Members and non-Members Contracting Parties to suggest additional topics. In total, 21 responses were received from Members, covering 19 States where the 2007 Convention is in force and two States where it is not in force.⁵
- 8 The PB reflected the suggestions that were received in a second questionnaire.⁶ The document listed 29 possible topics for discussion as well as six possible new tools for development. In total, 36 responses were received, covering 1 REIO (European Union) where the Convention is in force in 26 States, seven Members where the Convention is in force, two Members where the Convention is not in force and one non-Member where the Convention is in force.⁷ The detailed results of this consultation can be found in the Annex to this document.
- 9 All 29 topics proposed for discussion at a possible SC are considered a priority by a large majority of respondents, with 14 topics considered a high priority by a large majority of respondents, 12 topics considered a medium priority and three topics considered a low priority. Interest for new tools is lower, with four possible new tools considered a high priority by a large number of respondents, one considered a low priority and one considered not a priority. As a comparison, around 20 topics featured on the agenda of the First Meeting of the SC in 2022.
- 10 In view of the above, it is suggested that CGAP consider mandating the PB to start preparation for a Second Meeting of the SC, to take place in accordance with resource planning, including the timing for other SCs.

V. Outstanding matters / future work

A. Possible model declarations and reservations

- 11 At its First Meeting, the SC:
- “[...] noted that, while the 2007 Child Support Convention does not mandate any particular form for reservations and declarations, a more uniform practice could be helpful for existing Contracting Parties to easily identify the scope of reservations and declarations made by other Contracting Parties. The SC highlighted that such uniform practice could also facilitate the process of States becoming Contracting Parties to the Convention. To this end, the SC welcomed and endorsed the guidance for making reservations and declarations under the 2007 Child Support Convention proposed by the PB in Work Doc. No 30 of May 2022.

The SC noted that, in consultation with the depositary, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the PB will improve the guidance for the declarations under Article 2.”⁸

- 12 It is anticipated that the PB, in consultation with the depositary, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, will conclude its work on improving the guidance for the declarations under Article 2 in the second quarter of 2026.

B. Forms

- 13 At its First Meeting, the SC:

“[...] invited the Forms Working Group to work on the following forms, in order of priority:

- Fillable forms
- Model form for calculation of maintenance arrears / statement of arrears;
- Model form for Power of Attorney;
- Model statement of enforceability with respect to authentic instruments as well as private agreements (Art. 30(3)(b));
- Model form attesting that Article 36 conditions are met;
- Model form for calculation of interest;
- Scalable model form for decisions;
- Model form to request a Status Report.”⁹

- 14 It is anticipated that the Forms WG will begin its work on the development of the aforementioned forms in the third quarter of 2026.

VI. Proposal to CGAP

- 15 The PB invites CGAP to consider the following Conclusion and Decisions:

CGAP took note of the high level of interest expressed to discuss topics in relation to the operation of the Convention and its Protocol at a Second Meeting of the SC.

CGAP invited the PB to conclude the work on improving the guidance for declarations under Article 2, in consultation with the depositary, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, in the second quarter of 2026.

CGAP mandated the Forms WG to begin its work on the development of several recommended model forms under the 2007 Convention in the third quarter of 2026.
