Leading up to the HCCH|Approach Event, the HCCH is pleased to announce the HCCH|Approach Media and Design Competition.

## Submissions

Entrants are invited to create an audio, visual, graphic or other representation of the protection of children across borders in general, or on any aspect of the HCCH 1996 Child Protection Convention in particular. There is no restriction on the medium of the submission, which can include original pieces of music, artwork, graphics, videos, cartoons, posters, or animation. Entrants will be judged on originality, clarity, ability to engage a wide audience, and relevance to the HCCH 1996 Child Protection Convention.

Submissions must be the entrant's original work. Works previously published or broadcast will not be considered. Submissions should be emailed to [secretariat@hcch.net](mailto:secretariat@hcch.net) with "HCCH|Approach Media and Design Competition" in the subject field.
