








Organisational context


- The Single Digital Gateway








Digital Services Building Blocks



E-stamping of documents and validation mechanism

E-documents are valid when,

- are stamped with estamps as described in eIDAS regulations
- have a unique validation code
- can be validated via an information system

e-APP development timeline

- It all started on April 2021 with the development of a small project for e-apostille
- From June 2021 we started collaboration with competent authorities in Ministries of Interior and Foreign Affairs
- On June 2022 we received a letter from HCCH proposing implementation of e-apostille
- On September 2022 we make a new start
- On March 2023 the implementation begins
- From 17 July 2023, Greece issues electronic apostilles



Scope of solution

- We decided that we should start with providing a solution for electronic documents issued by Gov.gr
- For documents issued outside Gov.gr, a different implementation is required

Legal changes

- In April 2023, a new law was voted stating that
 - the documents issued from gov.gr can receive an electronic apostille, via a web application
 - e-apostilles will be verified by a web application on gov.gr
 - all related issues will be specified in a ministerial decision
 - for documents outside gov.gr new joint ministerial decisions will be published

In May 2023, the ministerial decision was published



Technical implementation

- We utilized Gov.gr building blocks
 - Authentication
 - E-stamping of documents
 - Validation mechanism
 - Citizen Inbox
- Created a web application for issuing electronic apostilles
- Created a web application for verifying electronic apostilles



Technical implementation

- Created a landing page, with content in 3 languages, Greek, English and French
- The e-apostille creation and verification services are also available via gov.gr

Documents that can be electronically apostillised

The online application for the issuance of an e-apostille is provided for specific types of gov.gr documents that bear a unique verification identification number and an electronic seal of the Ministry of Digital Governance. Currently, issuance of an e-apostille can only be done on documents:

- · that you have self-issued from gov.gr or
- that have been issued by a Citizen Service Centre (KEP) / Municipality / Consulate upon application made by you in person and if your TIN number has been registered. These documents must have been issued from 13/10/2023 onwards.

Gov.gr documents that have been issued following an electronic gov.gr application to a Citizen Service Centre (KEP) are not eligible for e-apostille. The documents that can be electronically apostillised (e-apostilled) are the following:

- 1. Certificate of family status
- 2. Birth certificate
- 3. Certificate of citizenship
- 4. Certificate of next of kin
- 5. Birth registration certificate
- 6. Marriage registration certificate
- 7. Civil partnership registration certificate
- 8. Death registration certificate
- 9. Copy of higher education degree
- 10. Digital transcript of a secondary or high school diploma
- 11. Transcript of a vocational High School diploma

More types of documents that can be e-apostilled will be added in the near future, and you will be able to keep up to date with any changes to the procedure on this website.

Next steps

- Make available for electronic apostillisation more gov.gr documents
- Extend the e-apostille issuing application to documents outside gov.gr
