
Model with 10 standard items (Art. 4)

Other e-Apostille Aspects

Validly issued Apostilles must be accepted

No rejection for lack of regulation or legislation

Receiving authority may have specific requirements (admissibility, form or probative value)

Resolve rejections quickly and efficiently


