Convenio sobre Cobro de Alimentos y Protocolo sobre Obligaciones Alimenticias de 2007: actualización y trabajo futuro

I. Introducción

- 1 El presente documento da cuenta de los trabajos y avances logrados en relación con el *Convenio de 23 de noviembre de 2007 sobre el Cobro Internacional de Alimentos para los Niños y otros Miembros de la Familia* (Convenio sobre Cobro de Alimentos de 2007 o Convenio de 2007) y el *Protocolo de 23 de noviembre de 2007 sobre la Ley Aplicable a las Obligaciones Alimenticias* (Protocolo sobre Obligaciones Alimenticias o Protocolo) desde la reunión de 2025 del Consejo de Asuntos Generales y Política (CAGP). Los trabajos relativos al Grupo de Expertos sobre Transferencias Internacionales de Alimentos y al sistema electrónico de gestión de casos y comunicaciones seguras (iSupport) se presentan en otros Documentos Preliminares por separado.¹
- 2 La sección II presenta información sobre la asistencia pos-Convenio y la actualización del Perfil de País electrónico. La sección III presenta información sobre nuevas ratificaciones y adhesiones al Convenio y su Protocolo desde la reunión de 2025 del CAGP. La sección IV presenta los resultados de las consultas realizadas en preparación de una posible segunda reunión de la Comisión Especial sobre el funcionamiento práctico del Convenio y su Protocolo. La sección V presenta asuntos pendientes y trabajos futuros. En la sección VI se proponen posibles pasos a seguir para consideración del CAGP.

II. Ratificaciones y adhesiones desde la reunión de 2025 del CAGP

- 3 Tras el depósito del instrumento de adhesión de El Salvador en febrero de 2025, el Convenio entró en vigor para este país el 7 de febrero de 2026. Tras la ratificación de Colombia en marzo de 2025, el Convenio entró en vigor para este país el 1 de julio de 2025. Por último, el Convenio entró en vigor para Dinamarca el 1 de octubre de 2025, tras el depósito de su instrumento de ratificación el 30 de junio de 2025. El Convenio está actualmente en vigor en 56 Partes contratantes.²
- 4 No ha habido ninguna acción en relación con el Protocolo en este período.

III. Asistencia pos-Convenio y actualización del Perfil de País electrónico

- 5 Del 29 de septiembre al 1 de octubre de 2025, la OP impartió una sesión de formación de tres días sobre el Convenio a representantes del poder judicial y la Autoridad Central, así como a miembros de las profesiones jurídicas y funcionarios responsables de la aplicación de la ley en Azerbaiyán. También asistieron representantes del poder judicial de Kazajstán.
- 6 Desde la publicación del Perfil de País electrónico en agosto de 2025, 12 Partes contratantes han publicado por primera vez su perfil o lo han actualizado utilizando el nuevo servicio. La Oficina Permanente (OP) continuará invitando a los Estados que se adhieran al Convenio a que presenten su Perfil de País, de conformidad con el artículo 57(1) del Convenio.³

IV. Resultados de las consultas realizadas para preparar una posible segunda reunión de la Comisión Especial

- 7 Después de la reunión de 2025 del CAGP, la OP distribuyó un primer cuestionario⁴ con posibles temas de debate para una posible segunda reunión de la Comisión Especial e invitó a los Miembros y a las Partes Contratantes no Miembros a sugerir otros temas. En total, se recibieron 21 respuestas de Miembros, correspondientes a 19 Estados en los que el Convenio está en vigor y dos Estados en los que no lo está.⁵
- 8 La OP presentó las sugerencias recibidas en un segundo cuestionario:⁶ 29 posibles temas de debate, y seis posibles nuevas herramientas que podrían elaborarse. En total, se recibieron 36 respuestas: de una ORIE (la Unión Europea) donde el Convenio está en vigor en 26 Estados, siete Miembros donde el Convenio está en vigor, dos Miembros donde el Convenio no está en vigor y un no Miembro donde el Convenio está en vigor.⁷ Los resultados detallados de esta consulta se pueden consultar en el anexo del presente documento.
- 9 Los 29 temas propuestos para debate son considerados prioritarios por una amplia mayoría de los encuestados: 14 de ellos son considerados de alta prioridad, 12 de prioridad media y tres de baja prioridad. El interés por la elaboración de nuevas herramientas es menor: un gran número de encuestados considera que cuatro posibles nuevas herramientas son de alta prioridad, una es de baja prioridad y otra no es prioritaria. A modo de comparación, en la agenda de la primera reunión de la Comisión Especial de 2022 figuraban alrededor de 20 temas.
- 10 En vista de todo lo anterior, se sugiere que el CAGP considere encargar a la OP comenzar los preparativos para una segunda reunión de la Comisión Especial, teniendo en cuenta los recursos necesarios y las fechas de otras Comisiones Especiales.

V. Asuntos pendientes y trabajos futuros

A. Posibles modelos de declaraciones y reservas

- 11 En su primera reunión, la Comisión Especial señaló que, si bien el Convenio sobre Cobro de Alimentos de 2007 no impone ninguna forma particular para las reservas y las declaraciones, podría ser útil una práctica más uniforme para que las Partes contratantes ya existentes puedan ver con facilidad el alcance de las reservas y las declaraciones formuladas por otras Partes contratantes. La Comisión Especial destacó que una práctica uniforme de este tipo también serviría para facilitar a los Estados el proceso de convertirse en Partes contratantes del Convenio. A este respecto, la Comisión Especial acogió con satisfacción y aprobó las orientaciones para formular reservas y declaraciones en relación con el Convenio sobre Cobro de Alimentos de 2007, propuestas por la OP en el Documento de Trabajo N.º 30 de mayo de 2022.

La Comisión Especial señaló que, en consulta con el depositario (el Ministerio de Asuntos Exteriores del Reino de los Países Bajos), la OP mejorará las orientaciones para formular declaraciones con arreglo al artículo 2.⁸

- 12 Se prevé que la OP, en consulta con el depositario (el Ministerio de Asuntos Exteriores del Reino de los Países Bajos), concluya la labor de mejora de las orientaciones para formular declaraciones con arreglo al artículo 2 durante el segundo trimestre de 2026.

B. Formularios

- 13 En su primera reunión, la Comisión Especial invitó al Grupo de Trabajo sobre Formularios a trabajar en los siguientes formularios, según el siguiente orden de prioridad:

- formularios rellenables;
- formulario modelo para el cálculo de atrasos en el pago de alimentos / declaración de atrasos;
- formulario modelo para otorgar un poder;
- modelo de declaración de ejecutabilidad de documentos auténticos y acuerdos privados (art. 30(3)(b));
- formulario modelo que acredita el cumplimiento de las condiciones del artículo 36;
- formulario modelo para el cálculo de intereses;
- formulario modelo escalable para las decisiones;
- formulario modelo para solicitar un informe de situación.⁹

- 14 Se prevé que el Grupo de Trabajo sobre Formularios comience a trabajar en la elaboración de estos formularios durante el tercer trimestre de 2026.

VI. Propuesta para el CAGP

- 15 La OP invita al CAGP a considerar las siguientes Conclusiones y Decisiones:

El CAGP toma nota del alto nivel de interés expresado por debatir temas relacionados con el funcionamiento del Convenio y su Protocolo en una segunda reunión de la Comisión Especial.

El CAGP invita a la OP a concluir el trabajo de mejora de las orientaciones para formular declaraciones en virtud del artículo 2, en consulta con el depositario (el Ministerio de Asuntos Exteriores del Reino de los Países Bajos), durante el segundo trimestre de 2026.

El CAGP encomienda al Grupo de Trabajo sobre Formularios comenzar a elaborar los formularios recomendados para el Convenio de 2007 durante el tercer trimestre de 2026.
