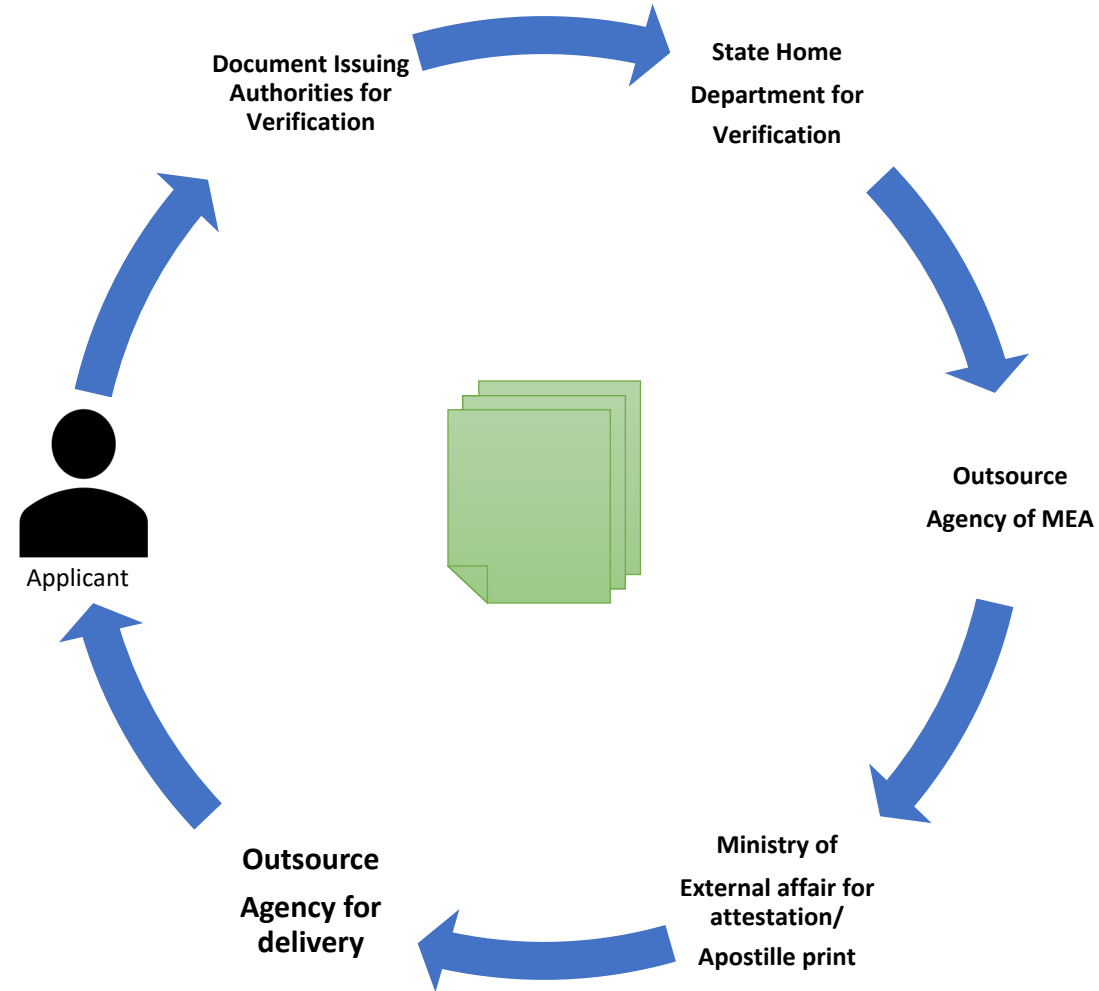

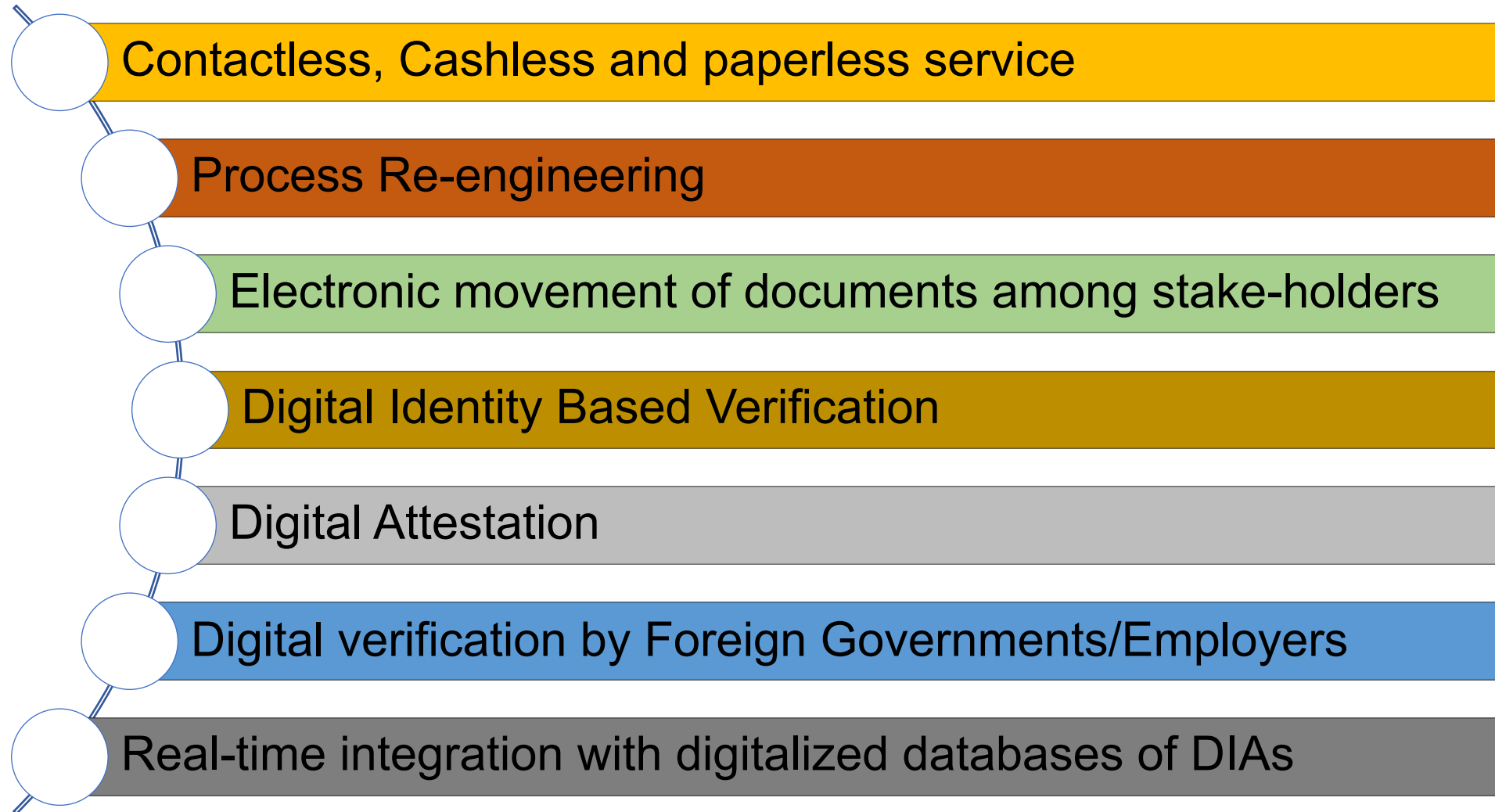


Movement of Documents: Pre eSanad



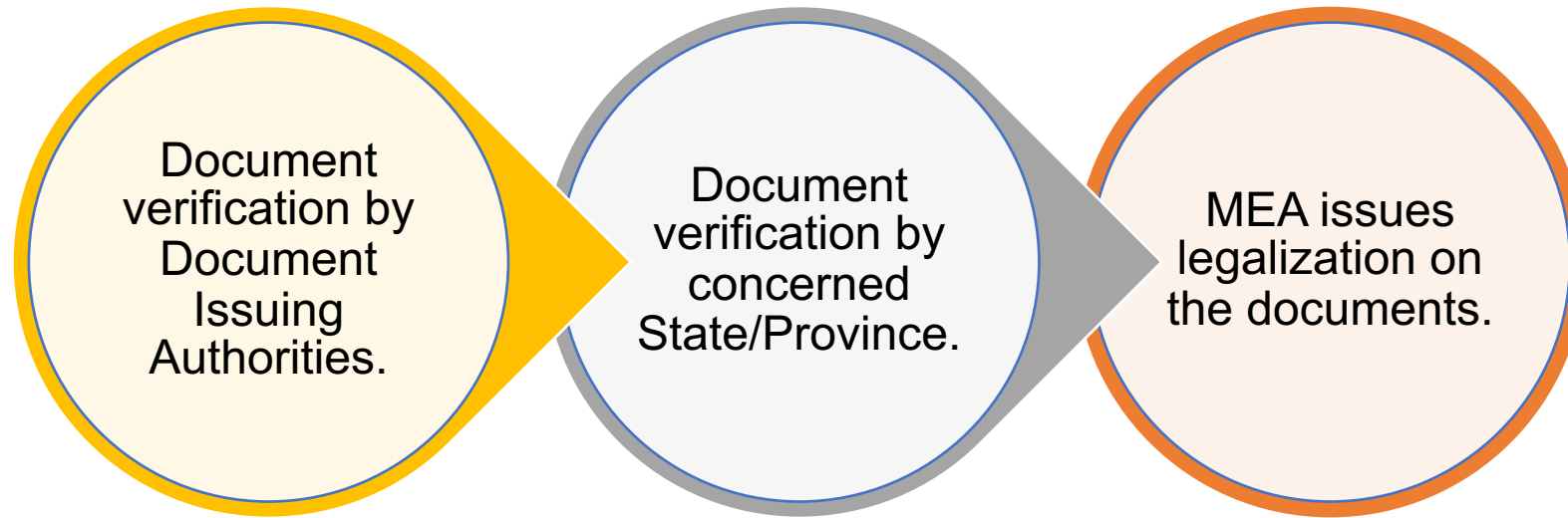


eApostille/ eSanad: The Objective



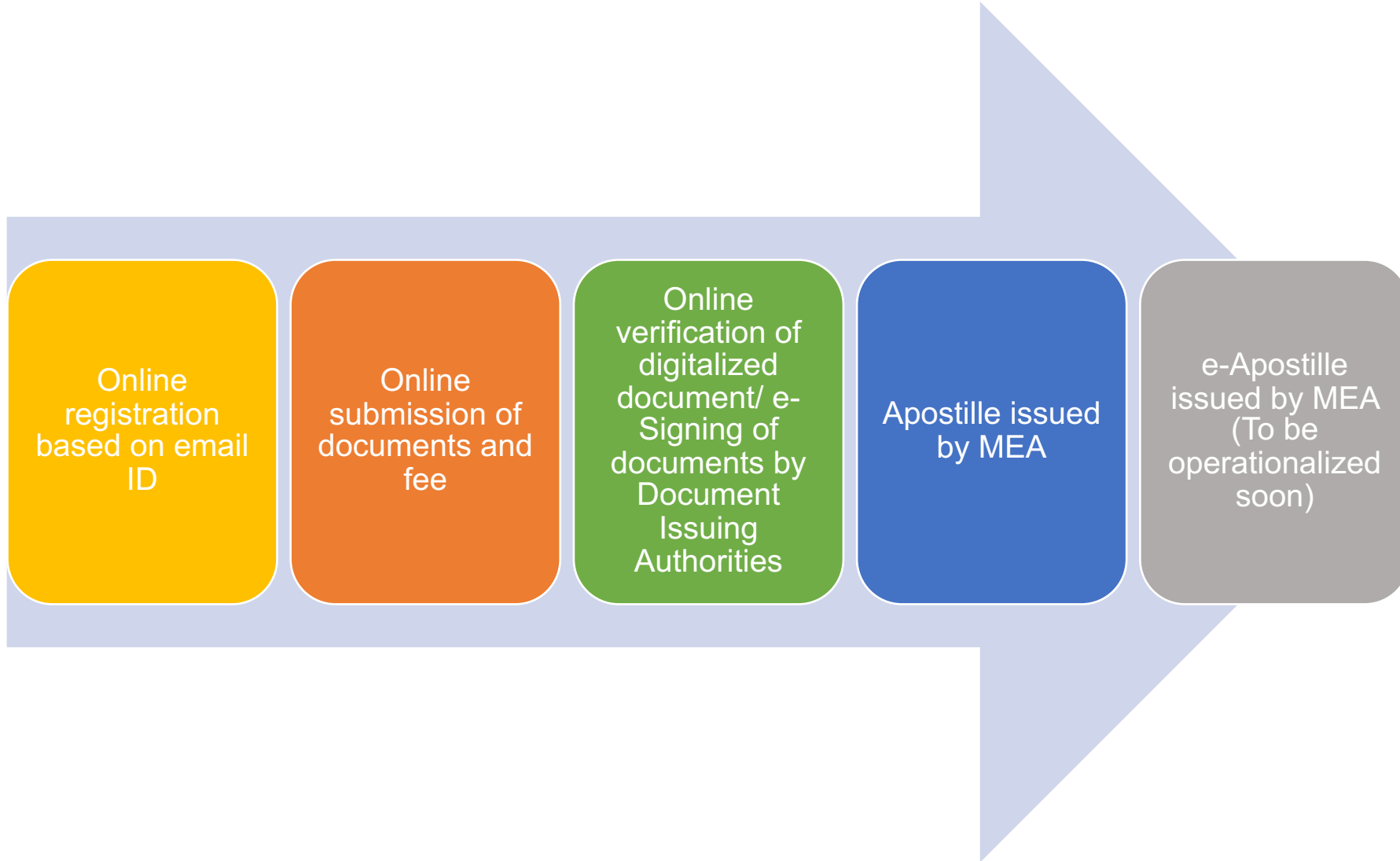


Process Steps of Legalization

Models of Integration With DIAs

Model-1

Integration with depositories where the digitally signed documents are being issued and available in digital form.

Model-2

Integration with depositories where digitally signed documents, are created during attestation of documents by State Government.

Model-3

Extending e-Sanad system to State GADs/DIAs for digital approval of documents. For the legacy documents and the documents issued in paper form.



Work-flow Model-1

01

The applicant uploads Meta data.

02

System shall verify availability of e-Signed document in repository and allows for online payment

03

The concerned MEA officer verifies the document and grants or reject the service.

04

Apostille is issued by MEA and pasted on the printed copy of digitally signed document.

05

A SMS message is sent to applicant with the status

06

Apostille document is dispatched to applicant.

07

Eventually, digitally signed Apostille (e-Apostille) shall be issued.

Work-flow Model-2

01

Applicants gets verification service from State Government.

02

The applicant uploads Document ID issued by State Government.

03

System shall verify availability of e-Signed document in repository of State Government and allows for allows for online payment.

04

The concerned MEA officer verifies the document and grants or reject the service.

05

Work-flow Model-3

01

The applicant uploads Meta data and PDF document and proceeds for online payment.

02

Document uploaded by applicant is electronically sent to concerned DIA/GAD's account on eSanad System.

03

Document is verified by concerned DIA/GAD and digitally signed.

04

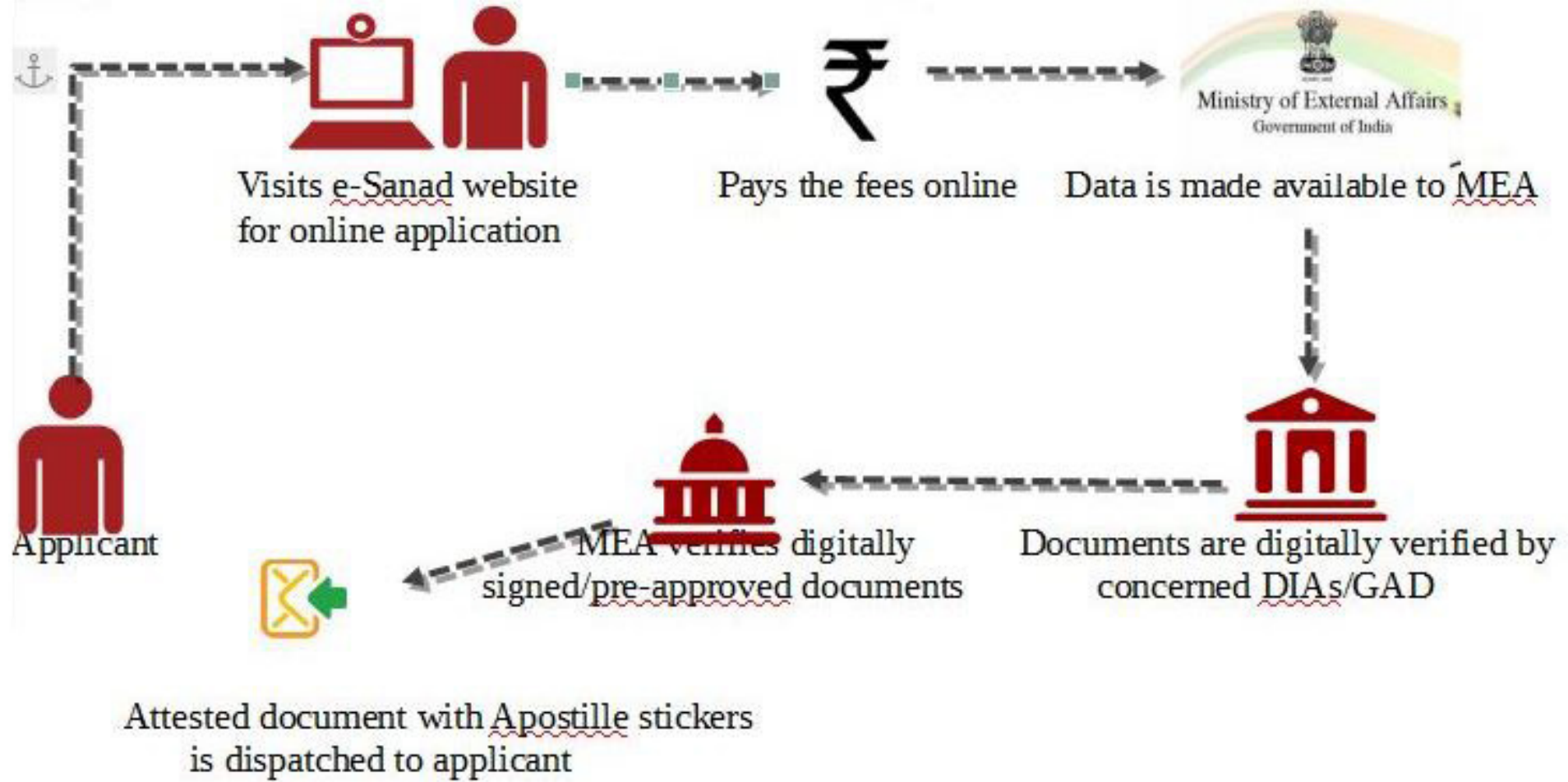
The concerned MEA officer verifies the document and grants or reject the service.
