





THE ORGANISATION

- Intergovernmental organisation with origins dating back to 1893
- Legislative mandate: "progressive unification of the rules of private international law" (Art. 1, HCCH Statute)
- Develops international treaties "HCCH Conventions" and other instruments – and monitors their practical operation
- Practical impact for individuals, families, and companies



THE HCCH IN A GLOBAL WORLD

Removing legal obstacles

- Facilitating trade, commerce, and investment
- Supporting access to justice and dispute resolution
- Promoting rule of law and respect for human rights

Creating a coherent cross-border framework

- Providing legal certainty and predictability
- Enabling effective cooperation in an established network
- Respecting diversity of legal systems

Removing legal obstacles

- Long-term sustainability and encouraging use of technology
- Regular monitoring of operation: post-Convention services and assistance







1961 APOSTILLE CONVENTION



- 127 Contracting Parties
- Replaces legalisation with a simple, one-step procedure
- Competent Authority
- e-APP




WHAT IS A PUBLIC DOCUMENT?

- All documents other than those issued by persons in their private capacity = any document executed by an authority or person in an official capacity
- General rule: if a document was subject to legalisation in a State before the entry into force of the Apostille Convention, it will now have to be apostillised
- The law of the State of Origin determines the public nature of a document, and whether an Apostille should be issued
- The law of the State of Destination determines the probative value of the public document




LEGALISATION CHAIN

COMPETENT AUTHORITY FUNCTIONS

- 1. Verifying the authenticity (origin) of public documents
- 2. Issuing (and attaching) Apostilles
- 3. Recording
 Apostilles in a register



COMPETENT AUTHORITY(IES)

- One or more Competent Authorities different models in place, each Contracting Party may determine what is best for them
- Importance of *proximity* to users (public) decentralisation / online options (e-APP)



(e-APP)



WHAT IS THE e-APP?

- Seeks to promote and encourage the use of technology under the Apostille Convention
- Improves accessibility and usability of the Convention using commonly available technologies
- Streamlines work processes of Competent Authorities,
 generates more user-friendly Apostilles, and enhances security of cross-border transfer of documents





THE TWO e-APP COMPONENTS

e-Apostilles

- An Article 3(1) Certificate issued in electronic form
- Signed by electronic signature with a digital certificate
- e-Apostilles may be issued on electronic documents or on paper documents that have been scanned/converted into electronic form


e-Register

- The Article 7(1) register maintained in a publicly accessible, electronic form
- Allows any interested person to verify their Apostille online
- Publicly accessible elements may differ amongst Contracting Parties (also depending on privacy laws)





Two Components






FUNCTIONAL EQUIVALENCE

"an Apostille validly issued in one Contracting Party to the Convention must be accepted in another Contracting Party to the Convention"

(but receiving authority may have specific requirements for underlying public document – admissibility, form or probative value)








Implementation of e-Register component 2006 - 2024
