Where a Contracting Party has indicated that the fee differs, the Permanent Bureau has determined an average fee, of which a breakdown has been provided in the corresponding footnote. The amount indicated in column three has been calculated by the Permanent Bureau based on the exchange rates on **29 September 2016** available at < www.xe.com>.
